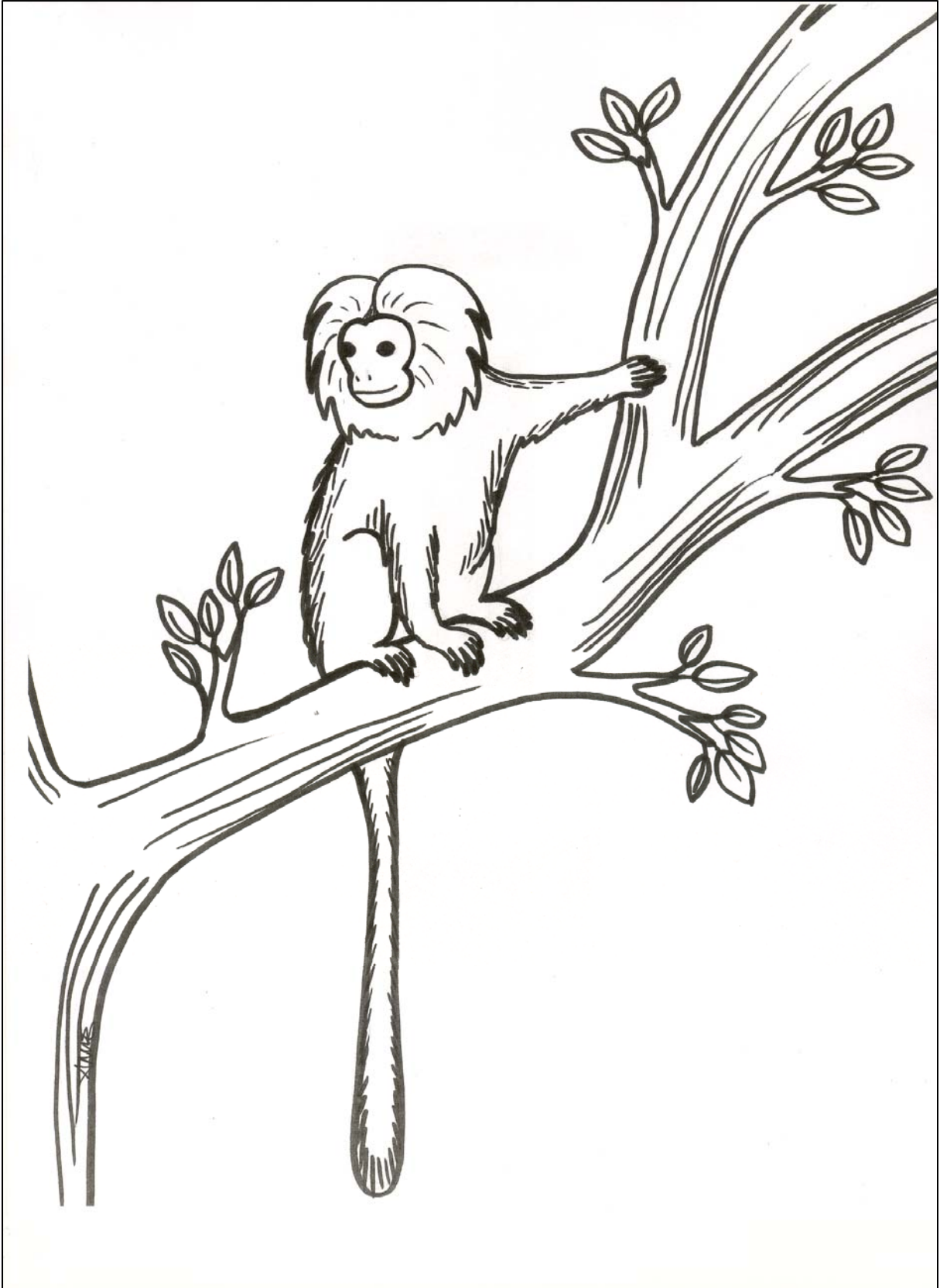


Golden Lion Tamarin
(*Leontopithecus Rosalia*)



Golden lion tamarins live in the rapidly diminishing Atlantic coast forests of Brazil. Their fur is reddish-orange to golden brown in color, with a full mane encircling their heads.
